Approval May 16th, 2013 Minutes and Financials: Motioned by Sheldon Rice and seconded by Manny Jimemez. Motion passes unanimously.

Financial Update: Nick Kollias explained the SSA Commissioners that there are a few line items that are underperforming and a couple of other line items that appear to be more active. Specifically, Nick brings to the SSA Commissioners' attention that in order to maintain the WiFi program but also the security patrol services, there might be a need for more funding in the current months. Nick proposes to analyze all the line items and bring back to the Commission real time projections before the SSA Commissioners move around dollar amounts. Nick mentions that it will also be better to get the business community's feedback during the Mid-Year assessment survey to have a better feeling of what the business community really needs. Mark DiValerio comments that detailed dollar amounts and cost projections need to be reviewed before any budget changes take place. Many Jimenez highlights that having the security patrol around the SSA is important and if businesses don't feel safe, they wouldn't stay in business for too long. Gint Cepenas and Mark DiValerio highlight the WiFi program and are in support of increasing the funding under this category. Nick Kollias states that GSDC will collect survey data, analyze cost projections for all the categories and bring back to the SSA board a few solutions to consider.

Security: Nick Kollias mentions Security funding will run out by October if changes are not made with the current size of the patrol force. Moving funding from underperforming areas

toward security or downsizing are possible options. Nick highlights again that this could be a decision for the board after the Mid-Year assessment takes place.

Additional Updates: Tina James provided status on the WiFi project. Tigress façade rebate is introduced by Nick Kollias. Gint Cepenas motions to approve rebate. Motion seconded by Manny Jimemez. Motion passes unanimously.

Adjournment: Motioned by Sheldon Rice and seconded by Gint Cepenas. Motion passes unanimously.

Upcoming Holiday Programs Update: Nick Kollias presented the update on the organization of the holiday celebration month. The RFP process and three quotes for the event were presented and discussed along with the choice of advertising newspaper.

Other Business: Nick Kollias brought to the commissioners' attention several complaints he had received about the number and color of the banners along 63rd Street. He requested that the commissioners consider whether they would prefer to hang half as many banners and/or limit to one or two different colors, rather than the current three in the spring banner design.
